7. *k η tóm '100'	*hundam (Unstressed 'm' > 'n'.)
8. *skēt- 'harm'	*skē θ (schaden)
9. *kap- 'lift'	*haf-
10. *ghrabh- 'dig'	*grab-
11. *kailo- 'whole'	*haila-
12. *kóselo- 'kind of tree'	*hasela-
13. *ghosti- 'stranger'	*gasti-
14. *swād- 'sweet'	*swōt (süß, sweet)
15. *tong- 'feel'	* θ ank-a
16. *t η b- 'village'	θ urp-
17. *dekm< 'ten'	texun (Unstressed 'm' > 'n'.)
18. *spreg- 'speak'	sprek- (Gmc. has forms with and w/o r.)
