### 1. Verb inflection

MHG	OHG
ich nime	ih nimu
du nimest	du nimis
wir nemen	uuir nemem, nemamēs

### 2. Pronouns

MHG	OHG
im, ime	imo 'ihm'
sie, sî	siu 'sie'
ir, ire	iro 'ihr'

### 3. Noun inflection: masc. *i*-stem

MHG	OHG	
gest(e)n	gestim	'guest', dative plural
geste	gestio	'guest', genitive plural
-----	gast(i)u	'guest', singular instrumental

### 4. Sound patterns

MHG	OHG	
tac	tag	'day'
tisch	tisc	'table'
lît	ligit	'he/she lies'
